This year's Pillow Boot collection (shown above) is a trio of styles in optional colourways. The original boot (in the middle row) is available in the 1976 tan colour (at right) or mid-brown and black (\$270). Above the originals is a row of wedgeified PBs in black or brown leather (\$295), while the bottom row offers a knee-high quilted leather with cuff puff detailing (\$325).

Cougar is currently taking the Pillow Boot on the road with a traveling pop up fitting room. I was invited to drop by during the Cougarmobile's stop in Toronto's fashion district where the boots were on display and a choice of fun backdrops for a photo op.
