

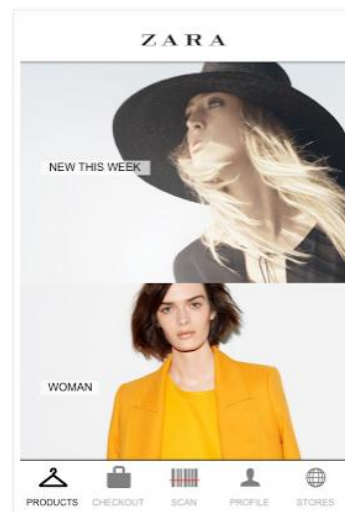

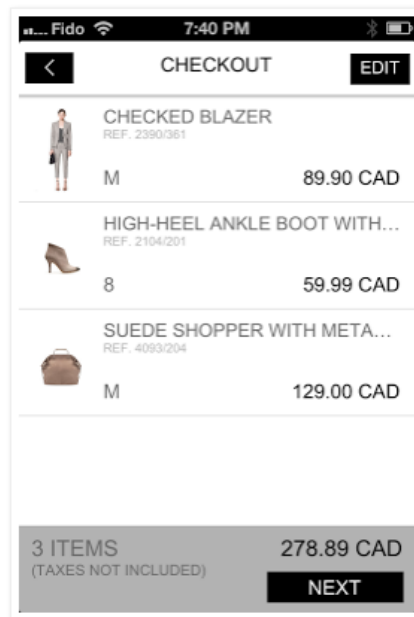
Zara Launches Canadian Online Shopping!



If you are lucky enough to have a Zara store near where you live, then you probably love it as much as I do. I used to drive an hour just to be able to shop at one, and was beyond thrilled when they opened two within 15 minutes of where I live, so I can just pop over to Maplevue Centre in Burlington or Square One in Mississauga to get my fix. And if you are one of those poor souls who have had the pleasure of visiting Zara, but live too far away, I'm sure you will be just as thrilled that they now offer online shipping in Canada! Part of the retail giant Inditex, Zara has almost 2000 stores in 73 countries across the globe. And because they are the designers, manufacturers AND retailers, they can produce the hottest, most current styles far faster than most of their contemporaries.



Starting March 6, you can place an order online at www.zara.com and find all of the hottest fashions, footwear (have you seen their shoes?!), and accessories for women, men and kids and place your order, which can be delivered to your home or to the nearest Zara location. Standard delivery is just \$4.95 CAD, with free shipping for orders over \$50. Express delivery is available for \$9.95 CAD, and if you choose to have your package delivered to a store, shipping is free. If you choose the store delivery option, you will receive a text message when your package is available for pick-up, and you will have 15 days to collect it. If you need to return your purchases, you can do so within 30 days at a Zara location, or have it picked up at your home at no charge.



You can also download the Zara App on iTunes and shop directly from your iPhone. You will be amazed at how simple the interface is, and how easy it is to order all of the latest styles with just a few clicks. And, as if better access to Zara's fashions weren't enough, they will soon be opening their first Zara Home store here in Canada, which will be located at Yorkdale in Toronto, and will undoubtedly which will undoubtedly cause mass chaos amongst decor-lovers.
